Frequently Asked Questions:

The Video is not available/lock symbol

The user must be logged in to their NCIHC member/guest account (ncihc.org) and the Learning Center. If a video is not accessible the user may not be logged in properly. Log out of NCIHC member/guest account (ncihc.org) and the Learning Center. Then log back in, starting with your NCIHC member/guest (ncihc.org) account and then the Learning Center.

If the quiz remains locked, review the System Specifications listed on page 12 for additional troubleshooting advice.

How do I find the webinars that I have already registered for?

After you are logged into the Learning Center, you can click on “My Account” found in the upper right-hand corner, and select “My Courses” to see a list of the courses you have already registered for.

The Quiz is not available/I couldn't watch the entire video at one time

The user needs to watch the entire video before the quiz becomes available. If you get disconnected,

you can advance to the spot where you left off and then continue from that point forward watching the rest of the video. When accessing the video again after stopping, start where you left off and do not skip a section. The viewer needs to watch the entire video before accessing the quiz.

Tip: If your viewing is interrupted, make a note of the time elapsed on the video. When you begin viewing again, advance to just before the time elapsed to continue viewing. Example: If you are interrupted at 45 minutes, advance the video to 44 minutes when you are ready to continue viewing.



Nothing seems to be helping, what else can I do?

- Try restarting your device.
